Maestro College - Student Grievance Policy

Dear Students:

Maestro College, Dallas location, has a Certificate of Approval from the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC), Career Schools and Colleges.

The school's programs are approved by TWC. Degree programs are approved by Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Step 1: Discuss the problem with the appropriate instructor or staff member.

Step 2: If unsatisfied, the student may appeal to the College Director.

Step 3: If unsatisfied after Steps 1 and 2, the student can appeal to the Board of Directors or a member of the Board of Directors.

All appeals must be in writing. If all appeals have been exhausted, students who are dissatisfied with this school's response to their complaint or who are not able to file a complaint with the school, can file a formal grievance with TWC, as well as with other relevant agencies or accreditors, if applicable.
